CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

We advocate for the creative and cultural development of children and young people across the country. Our programme includes:

New Producers: a professional development programme for young people looking to gain relevant experience in creative events and subsequently forge a future career.

EFG London Jazz Festival Presents: a showcase in the Festival of emerging young talent, with performances from youth ensembles, Music Hubs, universities and conservatoires.

Family Facing Concerts: bespoke live performances aimed at children and their families which introduce young minds to the world of jazz.

ShoW UP: a creative interventions project in South West London, supporting young creatives to work with industry professionals to refine their craft.

SPECIALIST SETTINGS
